## Guidelines to develop a knowledge exchange plan

The following guidelines are intended to help researchers reflect on how they can embed a combination of communication and partnership strategies throughout their work in order to drive positive societal change with their research.

There is no single correct structure for a knowledge exchange (kx) plan—feel free to use text, headers, diagrams, timelines, etc. The purpose of this document is not to prescribe a unique method to use, but rather to raise key considerations that help walk through the steps of the kx process.

Kx components	Some questions to consider (non-exhaustive)
Goal	What need, challenge or opportunity do you hope to address?
Collaborations	<ul> <li>Who are your existing partners and collaborators? How might their insights and expertise help drive the change you hope to create?</li> <li>Who will you work with? At what point will you engage with them, and to what degree?</li> <li>What resources will you invest to help your partnerships thrive?</li> <li>How will you gather, store, manage and share your data and findings?</li> </ul>
Audiences	<ul> <li>As you disseminate your research findings, who will be your target audiences?</li> <li>When will you communicate with these audiences throughout your research process?</li> <li>Which channels will you use, and why?</li> </ul>
Strategies	<ul> <li>What steps and activities will you put in place to achieve your goals?</li> <li>What opportunities and obstacles do you anticipate? How might you address them?</li> <li>What resources will you leverage (funding, UBC infrastructure, etc.) to carry these strategies forward?</li> </ul>
Feasibility	<ul> <li>Which of your strengths will you leverage to achieve this plan?</li> <li>Where do you need to build capacity, and how will you do so?</li> <li>Will you seek additional training in specific areas?</li> <li>Will you seek support from staff, colleagues, students, or partner organizations?</li> <li>Which components of your plan will require regular attention, and how will you sustain these pieces?</li> </ul>
Next Steps	<ul> <li>What are the next three steps you will take to achieve this goal?</li> <li>What core milestones will signify that you are making progress?</li> </ul>
