

Venture Showcase 2020

Post-event Report

Summary

Thursday December 10th 2020 marked entrepreneurship@UBC's inaugural <u>Venture</u> <u>Showcase</u> featuring over 30 ventures, their founders and champions in a day-long event spanning industries, programs and solutions.

Evolved from our annual Pitches & Pitchers event, the 2020 Venture Showcase spanned our entire funnel of ventures in our CORE and Lab2Launch Venture Building Programs to those raising in Phase 3 of our Incubator and HATCH Accelerator. Each team **presented in 3 minute increments with introductions from their Champion** (a mentor or Entrepreneur in Residence they have been working with) providing a unique look into the founder *and* team behind the solution.

Outcomes

Who pitched

The Showcase saw a **total of 31 ventures** pitching, with **8** in our Ones-to-Watch category (6 Lab2Launch and 2 CORE), **14** in our Sneak-a-Peek category (5 Lab2Launch, 9 CORE) and **9 in our HATCH Ready-to-Raise category** (4 Lab2Launch and 5 CORE) (see Appendix A for details).

Of the 31 ventures who presented, **52%** were **CORE** and **48%** were **Lab2Launch**. **19%** had a **Social Venture** affiliation, and **22.5%** had a **Climate Venture** affiliation.

Of the presenters, **29%** were **women**, with **71% men**.



Community Representation

At the outset of the day, we held a Fireside Chat with **Natalie Dakers,** CEO, Entrepreneur, Board Director, Leader in the Canadian Health Sciences sector and **Mike Hagerman**, Managing Director, DirectorsEdge sharing their insights and journey as key parts of our innovation ecosystem.

In addition, we held intimate "mini-sessions" Founder AMAs and Reverse Pitches featuring ventures, mentors and investors in our ecosystem in between sessions to create connections, foster community and allow for intimate knowledge sharing across our ecosystem.

Of the **9** mini sessions, we featured 2 alumni Founders, 1 Mentor and 6 Investors. Of these presenters, 33% were women, and 66% men (<u>see Appendix B for details</u>).

Lastly, we had **20 venture "Champions"** (Mentors or EiRs a part of entrepreneurship@UBC) giving an introduction and "setting the stage" for ventures who were pitching. Of the Champions, **30%** were women and **70%** men.


Attendees

The Showcase attracted **446 registrants across our UBC and regional innovation ecosystem**. Of the registrants, **35.5%** identified as **male**, **17%** identified as **female** and **47.5%** were **undisclosed**.

Investors

Of the 446 registrants, **84 identified as investors** (with 47 registrants having investor as their "primary", or sole, affiliation). **This represents ~19% of total registrants**.¹

Audience Outcomes

In total, we saw **392 unique attendees** across the day, with **131** attendees at our Opening Session Fireside Chat with Natalie Dakers and Mike Hagerman, **170** attendees at our Ones-to-Watch section, **172** at our Sneak-a-Peek category and **129** at our HATCH Ready-to-Raise category.

¹ Note: When registering, audience members are able to select more than one affiliation to entrepreneurship@UBC, hence why there are a total of 84 investor identified in total, but only 47 as their primary affiliation.



Net Promoter Score

The event garnered a **73+ Net Promoter Score (excellent)**, averaging to a **9/10** rating, with **72% of survey respondents saying it went "above" or "well above"** their expectations. Of the feedback shared, respondents noted they enjoyed "getting an exciting preview of the developing businesses" and "getting to know the diverse community of UBC entrepreneurs".
